Study groups



Seven target groups took part in the study:

- The program graduates: 123 surveys,
 5 IDI, 1 FGI
- Current scholars: 152 surveys,
 15 IDI
- Parents/legal guardians:
 107 surveys, including 10 phone interviews
- Regional coordinators: 8 IDI
- Principals of schools participating in the program: 14 surveys
- Teachers/councellors : 5 phone interviews
- Employees of the dorms where scholars live: 17 surveys verified on the phone

Survey response rate:

Scholars: 61%



"I had these plans before and I believe I would carry them out without the program, however it would have been harder to do."












The Education Dreams program impact on further educational plans








The perspective of returning to graduate's home town








What does it mean to be an EFC graduate








Program participation satisfaction






The program impact on educational opportunities

Additional English classes increase the child's language skills."








Overall satisfaction from child participation in the program









Overall evalutaion of working with the EFC Foundation








Impact of the 500 plus program on the financial situation of scholars' families
